Frequently Asked Questions

1. What is the [Helen Beiser, MD Resident Membership Award](#)?

This award was established to honor Dr. Beiser, a nationally known child and adolescent psychiatrist. ICCAP developed this award in her honor to carry on the commitment of continued growth in the child and adolescent psychiatry community.

2. Who is eligible for this award?

This award is open to child and adolescent psychiatry fellows and general psychiatry residents interested in child and adolescent psychiatry.

3. How do I apply?

To apply for the Helen Beiser, MD Resident Membership Award, applicants must complete the following:

- Online application form
- Upload a 300 word or less personal statement regarding your reasons for wanting to join AACAP/ICCAP
- Agree to the commitment of attending a minimum of two ICCAP meetings per year

4. When are applications due?

The deadline is generally early September of each year.

5. What do I win?

Winners of the award pay both their AACAP and ICCAP dues through AACAP's member dues payment process. Once that is paid, winners submit dues receipts to the ICCAP Treasurer who will reimburse winners for both dues.

6. What's next?

New trainee members of ICCAP will be presented at ICCAP's fall meeting generally held mid to late September and are required to attend at least two of ICCAP's meetings.
